

## Plugin View Text File

Use this [wiki plugin](#) to display the contents of a plain text (text/plain) file stored in the File Gallery. This is useful when you want to present static text content in a formatted and scrollable view directly on a wiki page. It supports configurable line ranges, display dimensions, line numbers, and file metadata.

## Parameters

Allows a simple plain/text file stored in a File Gallery to be displayed in a wiki page

*Introduced in Tiki 29. Required parameters are in **bold**.*

Preferences required: `wikiplugin_viewtextfile`

Parameters	Accepted Values	Description	Default	Since
<b>fileId</b>	digits	File Id of the .TXT file stored in a File Gallery	29.0	
<b>stopline</b>	digits	Display the file content stopping at this line (remembering that the first line is number 0 (zero))	29.0	
<b>height</b>	digits	Height in pixels	792	29.0
<b>startline</b>	digits	Display the file content starting at this line (remembering that the first line is number 0 (zero) - which is also the default value)	0	29.0
<b>width</b>	digits	Width in pixels	612	29.0
<b>showfileinfo</b>	n y n	logic flag to display the file info Yes/No	n	29.0
<b>showlinenumbers</b>	n y n	logic flag to display line numbers Yes/No	n	29.0

## Example

{viewtextfile fileId="2214" showfileinfo="y" width="600" height="700" showlinenumbers="y"}
```

This will display the text file on a wiki page as shown

This example displays file ID **1625** from the File Gallery. The viewer is **600x700 pixels**, shows **file information**, and displays **line numbers**.
